

**MINUTES FROM THE
CITY OF WAUTOMA
MEETING OF THE REGULAR/REORGANIZATIONAL COMMON COUNCIL
TUESDAY, APRIL 16th, 2024
6:00 p.m.**

Mayor Nixon called the regular and reorganizational meeting of the Wautoma Common Council to order at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 16th, 2024.

Alderperson Ryerson motioned to extend the noise ordinance and the Waushara County Fairgrounds by one hour to 10:00 p.m. for the annual Taco Fest on July 26th and July 27th. The motion was seconded by Alderperson King and carried 5-0.

Alderperson King motioned to approve budget authority of up to \$7,000 for an electrical box on South Ste. Marie Street. The motion was seconded by Alderperson Ryerson and carried 5-0.

Alderson Ryerson motioned to adjourn, which was seconded by Alderson Cayer and carried 5-0. The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
