

**MINUTES FROM THE  
CITY OF WAUTOMA  
MEETING OF THE SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL  
MONDAY, AUGUST 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024  
6:00 p.m.**

Mayor Nixon called the Special Common Council meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

Prayer and Pledge took place.

Alderperson King motioned to approve minutes from the Regular Common Council meeting held on July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024, Finance and Personnel Committee held on July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024, and Public Safety meeting held on July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The motion was seconded by Alderperson Ryerson and carried 5-0.

Administrator Bohler presented the review of bank account information.

Alderperson Ryerson motioned to approve the Council agenda. The motion was seconded by Alderperson Petersen and carried 5-0.

Members from the Wautoma Performing Arts Center spoke on a potential donation for new lights at their structure. The Common Council decided that a potential matching grant could be considered and that they would put it on the next agenda for discussion and potential action.

Alderperson Cayer motioned to approve the monthly vouchers, which was seconded by Alderperson King and carried 5-0.

Aldersperson Petersen motioned to adjourn, which was seconded by Aldersperson Ryerson and carried 5-0. The meeting was adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
